- Die dra van 'n vuurwapen ten alle tye is ook van waarde sodat jy vinnig kan reageer op enige bedreiging.
- Dit is raadsaam om jou gemeenskap veiligheid struktuur te aktiveer om ondersteuning te gee voor jy enige bedreiging konfronteer.
- Jy moet verskeie lae van vroeë

waarskuwingstelsels om en in jou huis hê, sodat jy voor iemand jou erf betree reeds van hom bewus is, of hom reeds laat weet het jy weet van sy teenwoordigheid.

- Daar is verskeie sulke stelsels beskikbaar: kameras, alarms, strale (beams) ligte met beweging sensors, knal strikke soos "Bang Alert", ens.
- Jy moet goeie sig vanuit jou huis (veilige plek) hê om te sien waar die bedreiging is, sodat jy dienooreenkomstig kan optree.
- Dit is belangrik dat elke huishouding 'n veiligheidsplan in plek het, en elke persoon presies weet wat om te doen in

verskillende situasies.

- Dit is uiters belangrik om by jou gemeenskap veiligheid struktuur soos 'n Plaaswag of Boere Unie in te skakel.

- Betroubare en effektiewe kommunikasiestelsels soos twee rigting radio's, Whatsapp, en Zello is ook van kardinale belang.

AfriForum beoog om sigbaarheid in Bronkhorstspuit op te skerp

AfriForum se Bronkhorstspuit- en Meyerspark-buurtwag het op Saterdag 29 Junie 'n hoësigbaarheidspatrolle in Bronkhorstspuit gehou om sigbaarheid in die gebied te verbeter en misdadigers af te skrik.

Kommunikasie en ander belangrike vaardighede word ook tydens hierdie patrollies opgeskerp.

"Tydens die patrolië het die verskeie buurtwagte die Bronkhorstspuit-area gepatrolleer," sê Hillel Coetzer, AfriForum se veiligheidshoof vir die noordstreek.

NOTICE OF WATER USE LICENCE APPLICATION FOR THE PROPOSED WATER USE ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATED WITH MINING ACTIVITIES AT LEEUWPAN COAL MINE BLOCK O1 WEST WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF VICTOR KHANYE LOCAL MUNICIPALITY IN THE MPUMALANGA PROVINCE

Notice is hereby given in terms of the National Water Act, 1998 (Act 36 of 1998) (NWA), Section 41 (4) of the intention to lodge a Water Use License Application (WULA) for the proposed water use activities with the Department of Water and Sanitation (DWS).

NATURE OF ACTIVITY

Exxaro Resources Limited ("Exxaro") proposes to mine Block O1 to increase mining productivity and extend the life of Leeuwpan Coal Mine ("Leeuwpan"). The mine operates following the requirements and conditions in the Environmental Management Plans (EMPs) approved by the Department of Mineral Resources. Leeuwpan consolidated all its EMPs on 25 April 2017, and this included mining activities at the new area called Block O1 which is an opencast and operation activities were planned to commence in the 3rd quarter of 2018. Accordingly, an Integrated Water Use License (IWUL) covering all listed activities proposed for Block O1 in terms of the NWA was obtained on 18 December 2015; which only authorises the development of a plant at this location, not a mine. During recent exploration activities, additional reserves were found in a section to the west of Block O1 which contains highly impacted wetlands systems, two pan wetlands surrounded by a hillslope seep wetland. In September 2018, a Risk Assessment was undertaken to determine the application approach, and the assessment yielded a medium score, which resulted in the requirement of a full WULA. As such, the proposed mining at Block O1 West will trigger water use activities listed under section 21 (c) and (i) of the NWA as indicated on the table below. Consequently, the requisite WULA must be lodged with the DWS to ensure compliance with the legislation and associated regulations.
